Year3

This week in topic we have been learning all about the Ancient Greeks, in particular looking at the fearless, frightening Spartans! In literacy, we have been building our skills to write some instructions for a delicious, reindeer stew from the Stone Age, using the book 'Stone Age Boy'. Year 4

In maths, year 4 have been looking at decimals and dividing 1 and 2 digit numbers by 10. In literacy, we have been looking at features of leaflets and what makes a good leaflet, ready for writing up our own leaflets for Yorkshire Wildlife park next week. Year 5

This week year 5 have been planning, conducting and investigating their own experiments with different forces. The children have focused on two forces, magnetic force and air resistance. We have conducted experiments into magnetic and non-magnetic materials. For air resistance we have looked at parachutes and whether the size of a canopy affects the time taken for an object to fall to the ground.
