Year3

In topic we have introduced our first Natural Disaster, the tumbling, turning tornado. We have learnt how they are formed, how they are measured and how devastating they can be! We have also learnt about Tornado Alley in the USA. Did you know that we have 30-50 small tornados in the UK every year? In Literacy we have been learning about how to improve sentences with adjectives and adverbs and in maths we are working with 3 digit numbers, finding 1,10 and 100 more and identifying missing numbers on number lines of different intervals. --@WBJyear3

Year 4

This week, Year 4 have delved deep into the Great Pyramids of Giza. As Egyptologists, we have investigated how and why the Pyramids were built and explored the inside of these ancient wonders. In Literacy, we began to look at diary entries and the key skills we need to write a diary, continuing to read our exciting 'Secrets of a Sun King' book. In Maths, we're tackling a new and tricky skill; rounding to the nearest 10, 100 and 1000. @WBJyear4

Year 5

This week in year 5 we have been looking at the key differences between rich Victorians and poor Victorians and how they lead their lives within the home. We have used photographs as a source of information to gain further understanding of what life was like for different classes. We have used our inference and empathy skills to imagine what it would have been like to be a child during that era. @WBJyear5

Year 6

This week, we have written some amazing diary entries in literacy, looking at how our book's protagonist, Rose Blanche, felt when she discovered a concentration camp. In maths, we have focused on honing our skills to do with addition and subtraction and in topic have learned all about propaganda in WWI. @WBJyear6
