### COVID Updates

Thank-you for your support in keeping cases to a minimum in all school community.

- We currently have no classes isolating
- We are open and expect all children to attend. Non-attendance will be followed up following our normal procedures UNLESS
  - Anyone in your household has symptoms - You should all isolate and arrange a test. If the test is negative the child can return to school
  - If you have been contacted by track and trace due to being in contact with a positive case, then you should follow the isolation instructions and inform us.
  - If you have a positive test in your household the positive person must isolate for 10 days and the others in the household for 14 days
