Protect your family and friends

If someone in your house tests positive, all those living in the house need to isolate immediately.

You should:



not send your child to school



not go to work



not leave your house (other than to get a Covid-19 test)



not have visitors in your home



ask friends or family to do your shopping or shop online

For everyone in isolation:



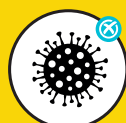
Keep in contact with friends and family by phone, video and online



Carry on hobbies and interests within your home if you are able to



Take regular exercise within your home if able to
