



Swimming Data 2020

Rationale

Swimming is a compulsory part of the national curriculum for PE in primary schools. At William Barcroft, we run swimming sessions in year 4, with top-up sessions for those that do not quite reach the required standard during year 4 at the end of year 6.

Explanation

- The required standard is to be able to swim 25 metres confidently and unaccompanied. This is also known as 'Grade 2'.
- 'Grade 1' is for children who have developed some competency in swimming, but are not yet at the required standard.
- Non-swimmers are children who have not yet mastered the fundamental basics of swimming, or have managed to swim the short distance of 5 metres.

Results

This year 39% of our departing year 6 children reached the required standard during their time at the school. **However, it must be remembered that this year, the year 6 children did not undertake their top-up swimming sessions due to the coronavirus outbreak.**

Results Breakdown

Level	Percentage
