Topics

Year 3

We are looking at Stone Age, focusing on how humans have changed over time and different settlements. In the last two weeks of term we will be studying Ancient Greeks.

Year 4

We are becoming explorers and heading to the rainforest to see how it impacts our daily life. We will be looking into the habitat of the animals who live there and debating the current environment such as palm oil and deforestation.

Year 5

During our topic of Space, the children will explore the universe and beyond! We will be learning about where gravity comes from, investigate the planets of the solar system and the children will then generate their own lines of enquiry.

Year 6

In topic this term, year 6 will be exploring the time of the Vikings. We will be exploring their life, ways and beliefs through the amazing book Beowulf.
