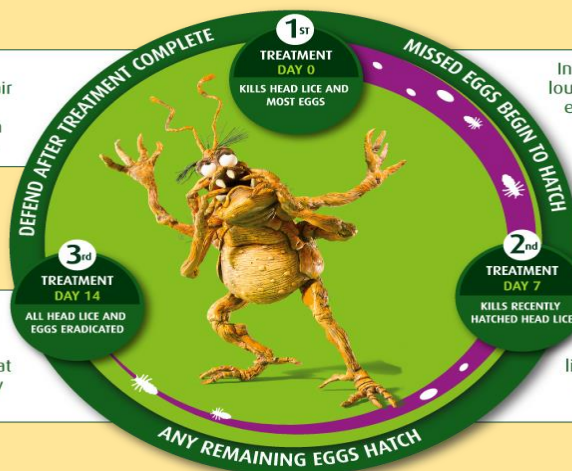

FACT 4

Nits hatch 6-10 days after being laid, continuing the life cycle and making infestation often an ongoing problem.
