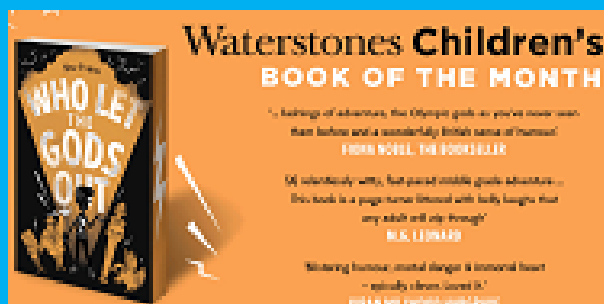


Year 4 Trip

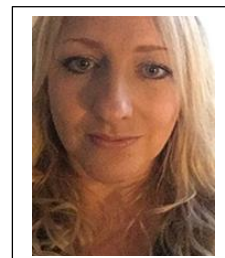
Author Visit -Maz Evans
