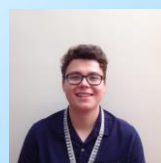

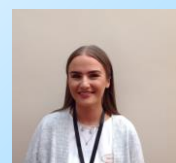

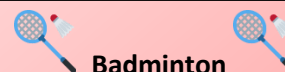
Please may you ensure your child has their kit in with these days. (including warm clothes for outdoor PE)
