The Ørsted Great Grimsby 10k is due to take place on Sunday 21st July 2019, 9:30am from Grimsby Town Hall. The race is quickly becoming a big event in the town and People's Park afterwards hosts a brilliant family fun day with lots of free activities.

I would like to draw your attention to the family fun run, sponsored by St Hugh's hospital which starts from the Town Hall and finishes within People's Park through a huge race arch. The fun run starts and finishes in exactly the same place as the 10k and will be sure to appeal to you if you want to walk, jog or run!

A special adventure trail, part of an active learning activity at the end of the race is also being set up by sponsors Ørsted to help young children and their parents get comfortable with discussing climate change. Children taking part will receive a new children's book, entitled "Is This My Home?" designed to help start conversations with young children about climate change.

Ørsted's Wonderful World Adventure Trail will feature characters from the book. With the aid of a special trail map, youngsters will navigate to the four corners of the earth and answer a series of simple questions to secure their prize – a free copy of the book, along with a bookmark that will point them towards tips on green action we can all take.
