### Cards


Pokémon/Football cards are not permitted in school. Please make sure your children leave their cards at home.

## Dinner Bands

After Easter we will be introducing a new system where the children will be given wristbands to get their lunches. This is only for school dinners and they will not be given to those on packed lunch who have not ordered a lunch. There will be three colours; one will be for children who can eat meat and one for those who are vegetarian due to religious reasons. Children who choose to be vegetarian won't be given this band but will still be able to make a vegetarian choice at the counter. The third colour will be for any child with an allergy which affects their food choices. This new system will help us to ensure that no mistakes are made when children are served and that only those who have ordered a lunch receive one.

## E-Safety

There have been recent incidents in our local area regarding predators trying to contact children via text and online messaging. Please be vigilant with your child's online activities. In school we teach children not to respond to anonymous messages and to inform an adult immediately. We also teach not to accept friend requests from strangers, but we need to work together to protect our children online. Discussing who your child is messaging, looking through their online devices together and talking about online safety can be a good way of checking their online activity without appearing intrusive.
